

# Juneau Explorers Week

Juneau-Douglas City Museum & Canvas Art Studio

August 9-13, 12:30 - 4:30 p.m.



**Monday: Medicinal Nature Hike:** Learn about the medicinal properties of plants found in Southeast Alaska with a *Discovery Southeast* naturalist. Then make beads out of Devil's Club at the Canvas. **Cost: \$30.**



**Tuesday: Treadwell Through A Child's Eyes:** Hear stories about growing up in the company town of Treadwell while viewing ruins and hiking the historic Treadwell Trail. Then head to Sandy Beach for Andy Goldsworthy - inspired art projects with Barbara Lydon from the Canvas. **Cost: \$32.**



**Wednesday: All Aboard:** Tour the USCG 110' patrol boat LIBERTY, learn about search and rescue, safety on the water and even go for a short boat ride! Make navigational flags at the Canvas. **Cost: \$35.25.**



**Thursday: Feathered Friends:** Explore the City Museum's exhibit *All Things Eagle and Raven* then take the Mount Roberts Tramway to visit the Juneau Raptor Center and hike a few short trails. Create your own eagle or raven sculpture at the Canvas. **Cost: \$35.25.**



**Friday: Gold Rush:** Hike to the Perseverance trailhead, pan for gold and tour the Last Chance Mining Museum. (There is no art activity today.) **Cost: \$30.**

Open to youth ages 8-11. Pre-registration & pre-payment required.

**Cost: is \$162.50 or pay for individual days** (see daily prices listed above).
